

Pastoralist Charged With Killing Abo

Alice Springs: Thursday.

Allegations that Robert Edward Davis, pastoralist, of Willowra Station, had shot two aborigines, killing one of them, for spearing, a cow, were made in the Supreme Court today when Davis pleaded not guilty to a charge of having murdered aborigine named Chuckara.

The Crown alleged that Chuckara and another aborigine, Billy Chung all, were on a "walk-about" , when they speared a cow. They were cutting it up when Davis and two other persons arrived. A chase ensued and it was alleged that Davis fired a number of revolver shots, one of which killed Chuckara.

The trial is proceeding.
