"I will be satisfied when the Aborigines get full land rights — and not until then," militant Aboriginal Gary Foley said in Adelaide today.

Pictured on his arrival today, Mr. Foley said: "When you have your back to the wall there is only one way out — fight."

He is here to raise money for South

Australian Aborigines so they can join the land rights demonstration in Canberra in November.

"The Government isn't doing enough for the Aborigines," he said.

"When we met the Prime Minister, Mr. Whitlam, he refused to guarantee us anything.
