

# Aborigines visiting China

**SYDNEY:** Ten Aborigines left Sydney yesterday for a five-week tour of China as guests of the Chinese Government.

They represent different tribal and fringe groups from each State except South Australia.

A spokesman for the group, Mr Gary Foley, said that the tour was for cultural exchange between the two peoples.

They had been invited by the China People's Association for Friendship of Foreign Countries.

"We will be looking at conditions for minority groups in China and will show them a film about the Aboriginal 'embassy' in Canberra and its destruction," he said.

"The Chinese want to encourage better understanding with the Aborigines and I hope we can invite the Chinese as our guests one day."
