Man tells of Valium

A man who had described himself as an Aboriginal revolutionary told Central Court today he had taken 16 Valium tablets because of strain at work before he committed a series of offences outside the High Court last year.

Mr Denis Bruce Walker, 29, of Mount Tamborine, near Brisbane, an administrative officer of the Aboriginal Community Health Ser-

vice, pleaded guilty to a charge of possessing a .22 calibre rifle outside the High Court in Darlinghurst on June 10 last year.

He also pleaded guilty to two charges of using unseemly words and to a charge of resisting police.

Mr Jones, SM, placed Mr Walker on a \$300 good-behaviour bond for two years for carrying the rifle and fined him a total of \$140 for the other offences.
